PAYMENT OPTIONS: We offer three payment options:

1. Annual Payment: Paid directly to MLMS by July 15, 2015.
2. Semi-annual Payments: Paid through FACTS Tuition Management Company on 7/15/2015 & 11/15/2015. \$10 yearly Registration fee paid to FACTS. Tuition insurance premium of 2.9% is added to 7/15/14 payment.
3. Monthly Payments: With the option of choosing 10, 9, or 8 monthly payments beginning in April, May, or June, 2015. \$43 yearly registration fee paid to FACTS. 2.9% Tuition premium will be added to monthly fees of each month prior to and including July 15. All payments will be completed by January 15, 2016. MLMS partners with the FACTS Tuition Management Company for payment processing. Payments are made through EFT or credit card to FACTS.

Tuition rates include supply fees for all programs.

TUITION REFUND PROGRAM: Families who choose to pay tuition in 2 or more payments are required to participate in the Tuition Refund Plan offered by A.W.G. Dewar, Inc. Premiums are calculated at 2.9% of annual tuition and daycare fees (rounded up to nearest dollar) and are due on or before July 15, 2015. The premium will be added to the above fees each month prior to and including July 15th.
