We are excited for everyone to be back on campus in just a few days! Below you will find some important information for the start of school.

Sunday, August 26th: Campus Beautification Day! Come help make our school shine for the beginning of the year! It is a fun way for families and teachers to reconnect before the school year is off and running.

Thursday, August 30 and Friday, August 31st: Many of you have scheduled Parent-Teacher Meetings with David Salgado and Mona Nixon for the mornings of Thursday and Friday.
